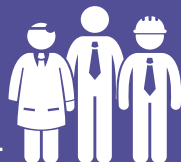

Strategic Employment Framework

Our innovative Strategic Employment Framework supports people who have experienced homelessness into employment, whilst supporting the business community to fulfil their workforce requirements and corporate social responsibilities.


The Framework is supported by Acorn Recruitment and offers ring-fenced employment opportunities, as well as work placements, volunteering and training.
