

Rough Sleeping: Swansea

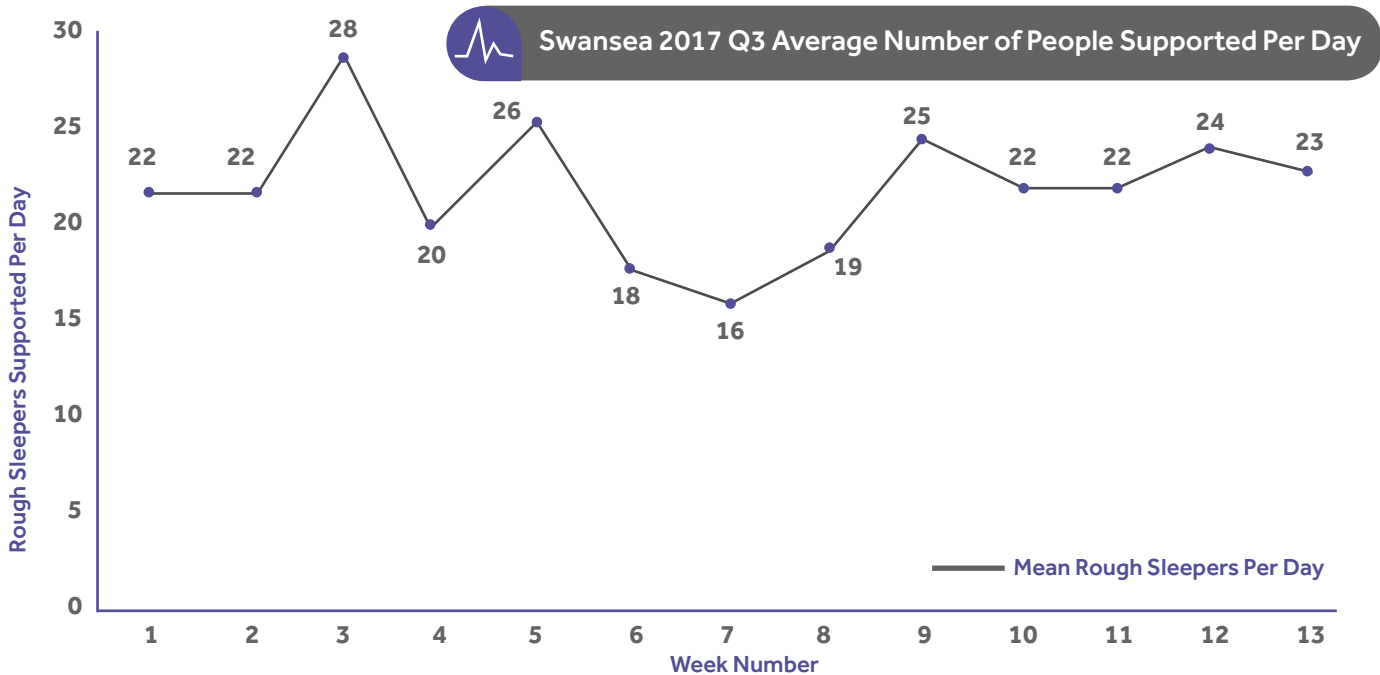


Our Rough Sleepers Intervention Team (RSIT) in Swansea provides humanitarian aid to rough sleepers in Swansea city centre. The data collected by the team over 13 weeks includes the age & gender of those sleeping in the city centre among other information.

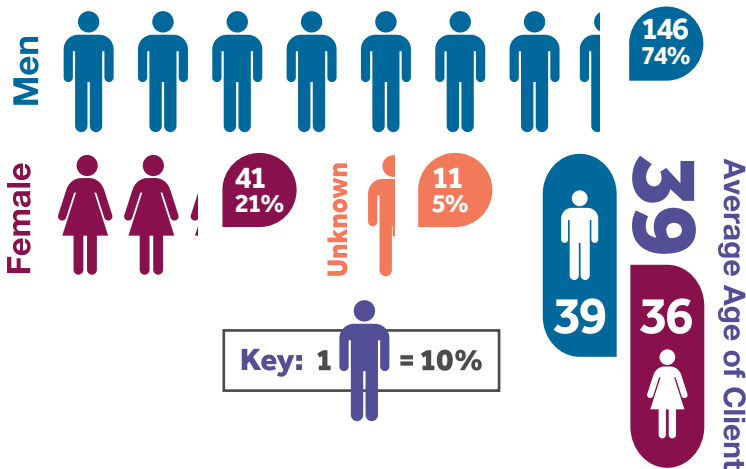
This research is not intended to provide absolute figures for rough sleeping in the city but does indicate trends over time in rough sleeping in the city centre.

These figures include records made as part of the Rough Sleepers Intervention Team counts as well as a drop-in service in Swansea. As such, some people recorded here might not be rough sleeping, but in most cases will be homeless or vulnerably housed.

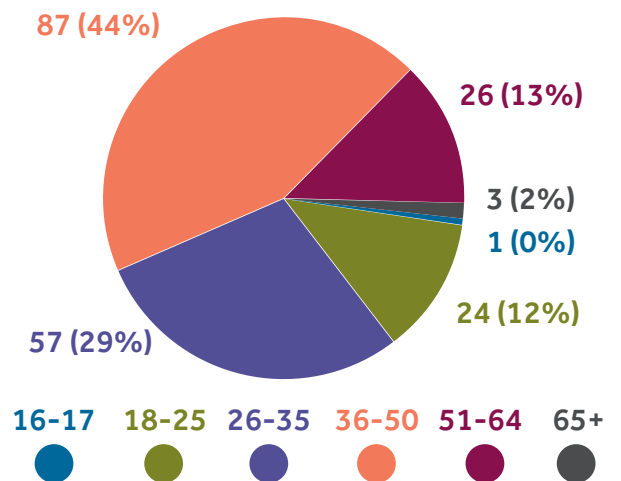
The results from Swansea suggest that there has been an **83%** increase in rough sleeping between Q3 2016 and Q3 2017.
