

Rough Sleeping: Cardiff

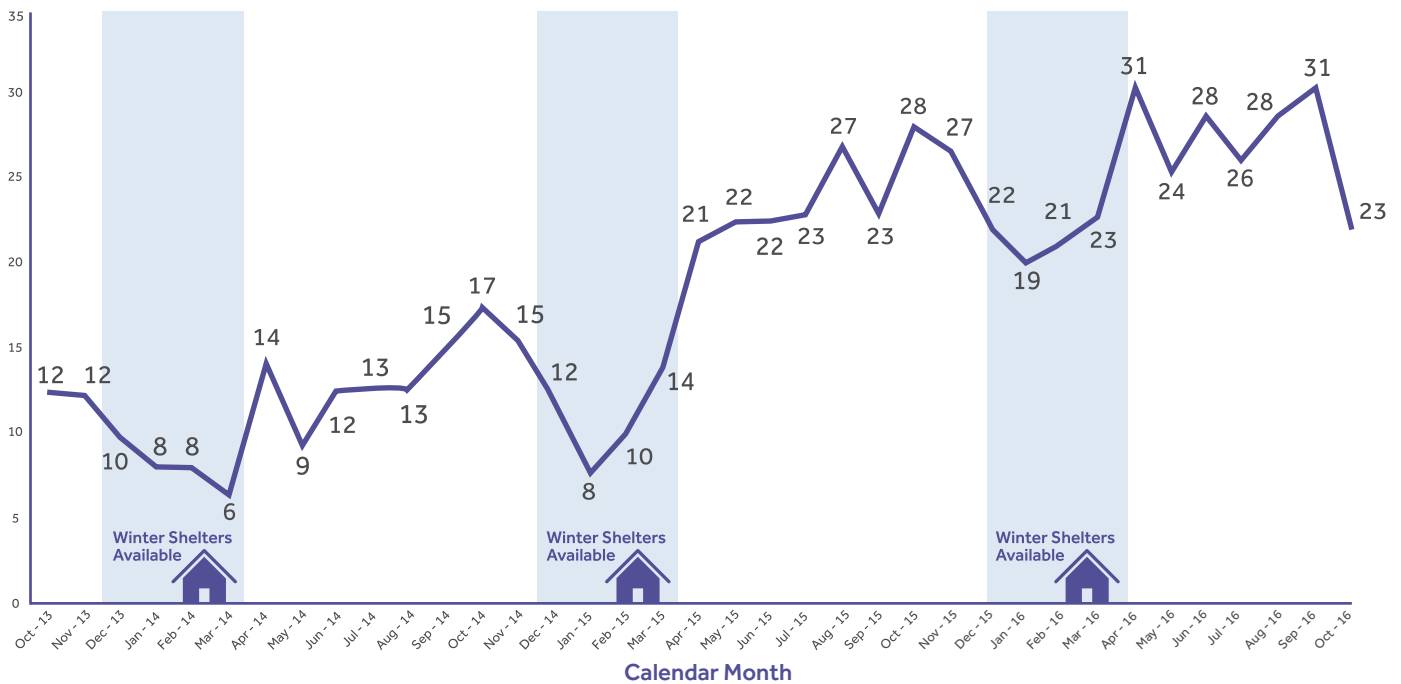


Our Rough Sleepers Intervention Team (RSIT) in Cardiff operates 7 days a week providing humanitarian aid to rough sleepers in Cardiff city centre. The data collected by the team over 25 months includes the age & gender of those sleeping in the city centre among other information.

This research is not intended to provide absolute figures for rough sleeping in the city but does indicate trends over time in rough sleeping in the city centre.

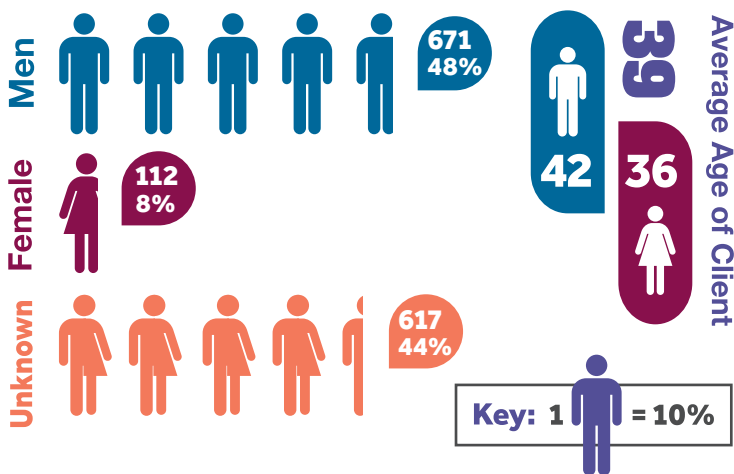
In Cardiff, we have seen a **81%** increase in rough sleeping between 2013/14 and 2015/16

Cardiff RSIT Rough Sleepers Contacted Per Day (Monthly Mean)

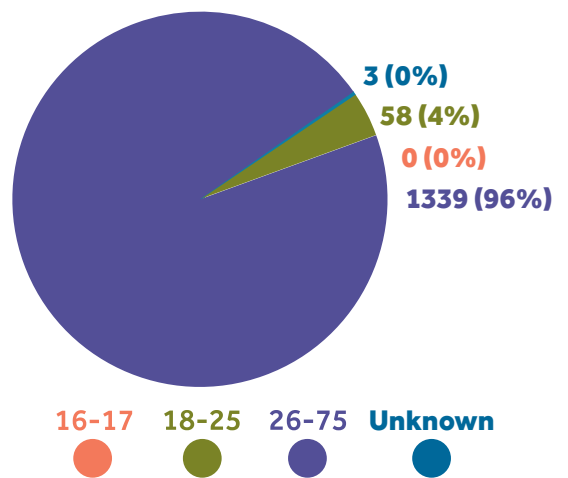
